
We would like to extend a warm welcome to our new Junior Infants and to pupils who have joined us throughout the school. We hope that they will be very happy here in Carbury.

School Punctuality and Attendance



The school **gate opens at 8.50 am** and formal **teaching starts at 9.10 am**. It is essential that pupils arrive on time for school as it ensures a smooth start to the day.

While certain absences are unavoidable, such as when a child is sick, it is important to remember that the school must inform the statutory Educational Welfare Services of the Child and Family Agency if your child has missed 20 days or more in the school year.

We strongly advise parents not to take children out of school for non-essential reasons e.g. holidays during term time. We do not provide schoolwork for children who are not present in school.

If your child is absent, you need to complete an absence note which is available on the school website in the 'For Parents' section.

*Check if you need to pay for parking.


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School Uniform

Support for Pupils



We have a designated sensory space in Carbury School. This space is used to enhance and promote the wellbeing and learning of pupils. Sensory spaces can reduce sensory overload for pupils who may find the school day overwhelming and enable them to achieve a calmer state for learning. In using the sensory space, we aim to provide pupils with the individualised sensory input they need to self-regulate so that they can be better prepared for learning and interacting with others.

As a school, we use a programme called Aladdin to set up ePayments. This enables parents/guardians to complete payments online. When we set up an ePayment, you will receive a link by email.

We have set up an ePayment of €50 per pupil on Aladdin to help cover the cost of photocopying, art supplies, digital resources and the Pupils Personal Accident Insurance with Allianz. This insurance provides every pupil with twenty-four-hour cover for school and leisure activities for the 2023/2024 academic year.
